- Competition regulations:** The competition regulations of the DDV and the DKV in their current versions apply, as well as the special regulations 2022 across all associations.
- Competition format:** Competition with two boats in the pulley-rolling method
- Boats:** Standard boat; provided by the organizer.
No own boats!
- Paddles:** Own paddles according to IDBF Spec 202a or plastic paddles provided by the organizer
- Participants:** For members of the DDV and the DKV as well as teams from European member associations
- Age group:** Open age group (minimum age for competitors 16 years)
- Competition classes:** Mixed (10 athletes; 6/4)
Open and Women (10 athletes)
Drummer: Mandatory (minimum age for competitors 12 years)

Without full payment of the entry fees before the start of the regatta, the participation of the entire club in the IIGDM is not possible.

If the championship is cancelled due to force majeure, the entry fee will be refunded less 10 percent for required advance payments.

Race program: Will be announced in the bulletin.
Preliminaries, semi-finals, placement races, finals

Hotels: There are sufficient accommodations of various categories available in the area. Reservations and bookings for hotels and guest houses must be made independently.

Arrival: with your own vehicle or by public transport (S-Bahn, tram, bus)

Parking: Available in the area around the swimming arena.

Catering: There is a snack bar in the hall, otherwise self-catering.

1. All athletes who have submitted their binding registration in accordance with the competition regulations or the announcement by 30.11.2024 and have paid the specified entry fee by 31.12.2024 are eligible to participate. It is up to the organizer to accept late registrations.
2. Participation in the International Indoor Dragon Boat Championship is not possible without full payment of the entry fee before the start of the regatta.
3. For your own safety, the instructions of the organization staff and their representatives must be followed without reservation.
4. Participation in the event is at your own risk. Any liability of the organizer and host as well as their assistants for personal injury or damage to property is excluded, except in cases of intent or gross negligence. The clubs are liable for their members and fan groups.
5. If people under the age of 18 participate, it is the responsibility of the club to obtain a consent form signed by a parent or guardian.
6. Every athlete must be able to swim at least in the clothing he/she wears during a race.
7. With his signature, the team captain confirms that neither he nor any team member are aware of any health restrictions that would prevent them from taking part in the competition at the required level of exertion.
8. Neither the organizer nor the host assumes any liability for lost clothing, equipment or valuables belonging to the participants.
9. If the event is interrupted due to force majeure (e.g. severe weather) and is consequently cancelled, the entry fees will be refunded pro-rate.
10. The areas provided by the organizer for the teams (swimming pool and changing and sanitary facilities) must be left by the participants after the event in the same condition as they found them. Costs resulting from any damage or pollution must be borne without exception by those responsible and will be invoiced by the organizer.
11. The person registering undertakes to make the conditions of participation and safety instructions available to each participant before the event and to adequately point out their content and significance.
12. The registrant confirms that the participants agree to the use of film and photographic work in connection with the event.
